When Bubbie and the matchmaker Hannah arrange a date for Izzy with a nice Jewish boy, Sam - the local pickle merchant, a generational and cultural clash erupts!

The play is titled after a major thoroughfare running through a New York neighbourhood on the traditionally Jewish lower eastside; and Uptown Manhattan on the other side. **CROSSING DELANCEY** oscillates between these two locations as we watch Izzy struggling to maintain her Uptown lifestyle while being lured back to the "old neighbourhood" by her wily Bubbie.
