Metro's fifth show of its 52<sup>nd</sup> season is a fast-paced new adaptation of Elizabeth Bennet and Mr. Darcy's intricate dance of misunderstanding and confusion.

**(January 30, 2015)** Based on Jane Austen's romantic novel of class, gossip and scandal, this humorous tale of love and values unfolds in the England of the 1812. The five Bennet sisters (having no brothers) have been raised with one purpose in mind: finding a wealthy husband who can support the family. They are not upper class and their house will be inherited by a distant male cousin if Mr. Bennet dies.

Sparks fly when the spirited Elizabeth Bennet meets single, aristocratic, and proud Mr. Darcy. In a classic courtship dance, Mr. Darcy reluctantly finds himself in love in with a woman beneath his class; Elizabeth (Lizzie) is influenced by the power of first impressions. Can each overcome their own pride and prejudice?

Director Joan Bryan says "I'd forgotten how funny Jane Austen is... and indeed what a really good writer she is. And to think she wrote Pride & Prejudice when she was 18 years old! What an eye to life around her."
